



THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE BOYLAN-HAVEN-MATHER ACADEMY ALUMNI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Boylan Haven-Mather Academy (BHMA) Alumni Memorial Scholarship, established at Clafin University, perpetuates the BHMA and Browning Home spirit as it relates to providing assistance to high school graduates who are descendants of former Boylan Haven, Mather Academy, and Browning Home students or students recommended by a graduate or former student of BH, MA, or BH. In the agreement with Clafin University, Boylan Haven-Mather Academy Alumni Association will be referred to as the Grantor and Clafin University as the Trustee.

An endowment fund which will be a permanently invested fund will provide an ongoing source of scholarship assistance to high school graduates that exemplify the principles and ideals of BH, MA and BH.

Regulations Governing Endowment Funds

1. **Eligibility Criteria.** The candidate(s) must be a descendant(s) of a Matherite (BH, MA, BH), or recommended by a Matherite (BH, MA, BH) and meet the following criteria:
 - a. An accredited high school graduate with a “B” average or above for the last four semesters of secondary school.
 - b. In need of financial assistance
 - c. Actively involved in co-curricular activities and community services
 - d. Recommended by Principal or Guidance Counselor
 - e. Accepted and enrolled at Clafin University with a major in education

If there are non-BH, MA, or BH related or recommended candidates, they must meet the above listed criteria.

2. **Application Process.** All applicants must follow the procedures in place at Clafin University to be considered for the BHMA Alumni Memorial Scholarship. All applications must be submitted to Clafin University. The application procedure will be placed on the BHMA website.
3. Scholarship Recipients must maintain a “B” average while receiving scholarship funds from BHMA Alumni Association.

No award need be made in a year in which there is no suitable candidate. The donor and recipient(s) of this scholarship should be recognized in the “Scholarship Appreciation Luncheon” program and, the donor in the “Honor Roll Donors” publication.
