MEMORIES OF MATHER, CLASS OF 1922

The class of 1922 was composed of 15 girls and 3 boys. 7 were boarding students and 11 were day students.

The well-rounded academic program included the following subjects: Latin, English, French, Pedagogy, Religion, Mathematics, History, Music, and Literature. In addition to the curriculum a strong emphasis was placed on the cultural development of students. Many plays and concerts were presented to the community by the students under the direction of the dedicated faculty. Those activities were extremely important in the life of the school and were tremendously supported by parents and the community.

Other class related activities included the annual observances of Religious Emphasis Week, American History Week, and Negro History Week. Chapel programs were planned for each day during the week of observance and students played major roles in its preparation and presentation.

Prayer services were held every Thursday night. Formal chapel services were held each Thursday morning. The girls were required to wear uniform (dark skirts and white blouses) but the same requirement was non-existent for boys.

Extra-curricular activities included basketball for girls and tennis for both boys and girls. There were no basketball or football teams for boys; those teams were organized in 1923.

Boys and girls were allowed to entertain only on Sunday afternoon in the parlors of Browning Hall between the hours of 3 - 5 p.m.

GIRLS BASKETBALL

The 1934 Basketball Team of Mather was "Fast and Furious". The "Female Eagles" appeared better in technique and showed more aggressiveness than last year's team. Mather's Team is recognized all over South Carolina as having good sportsmanship and standing. . . .

The first game of the season the Eagles swooped down upon St. Matthews and defeated them 16 to 17, but came back from Florence winning 19 to 7. Mayesville was next overcome by the Eagles 48 to 19. Sumter was defeated by the Eagles 24 to 37, but Mather lost in a return game 16 to 17. When St. Matthews and the Eagles met the second time in the "Gym", both teams were at their best, but Mather lost 33 to 19.

The 1935 Basketball Team will suffer a great loss in one who was faithful and true, their Captain, Margaret Harris.

Catherine Moore, one of the new and young members of the Team, was unanimously elected captain of the 1935 Basketball Team.

STATE TRACK MEET

Mather boys entered the State Track Meet this year for the first time. They were proud to bring home several honors, including the Trophy.

Gibbs DuBose won first in the 110 meter dash, breaking through in eleven seconds, while Johnnie Williams (9th) came in second, with a record of 11 1/2 seconds, and Fred Williams, third, with a record of 12 seconds. The half-mile race was won by Theodore Sutton, and Johnnie Williams was second. In the high-jump, Fred Williams took first place, jumping 5 ft. 1 3/4 inches. The same four boys took first places in relays. In the broad jump, Gibbs made third place.

This made a total of 30 points. These boys are planning to be in form next year, and bring the Trophy home again, to keep always.
