III. Each Teacher shall furnish a letter on general topics connected with the work, using for this purpose the blank pages of the report. (To do this more readily, keep memoranda during the month and write upon the following among other topics; namely: (a.) Condition and progress of school; (b.) Branches in which most rapid progress is made; (c.) Sunday school and other Religious matters; (d.) Industry and employment of Freedmen; (e.) Interesting incidents; (f.) Discouragements.

IV. Each Teacher shall make a full Financial Statement each month, (page four of Blank.) Teachers' expenses may be paid in advance, but salary will not be allowed until the Monthly Report is received.
